

## Pre-FORUM Workshop Motivational Interviewing: Supervising and Mentoring

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Training research has clearly shown the importance of ongoing coaching and feedback when learning MI. This 2-day pre-Forum workshop is for MINTies who have an ongoing relationship with the staff of a particular agency or system, and who want to strengthen their skills in supervising and mentoring others who are learning MI. Among the topics addressed will be:

- ◆ A variety of training methods to help practitioners develop and increase their competence in MI
- ◆ Methods for reviewing and coding MI sessions and tapes, with attention to aspects of practice that most impact client outcome
- ◆ Developmental sequencing of MI training for individuals and groups
- ◆ Tools and methods for providing structured objective feedback on practice
- ◆ Coaching for skill improvement
- ◆ Quality assurance and quality improvement systems
- ◆ Various approaches for supervising and mentoring in an MI-consistent manner, either face-to-face or via audio or video links
- ◆ Implementing MI within ongoing systems
- ◆ Integrating MI practice with other clinical methods

Lunch for the workshop is included each day. Participants must be MINT members and be registered to attend the FORUM; substantial prior experience with MI practice and training will be assumed.
